Our Programs

School Health Initiative: addressing challenges related to poverty, unhygienic home and school surroundings, malnutrition and widespread prevalence of communicable diseases by improving overall health and well-being of underprivileged school children in rural Bangladesh

Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS): Bangladesh: the first and only American Heart Association (AHA) International Training Center in Bangladesh to offer Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) and Basic Life Support (BLS) courses

Advanced Pediatric Life Support (APLS): Bangladesh, Zimbabwe, Philippines: global educational programs focused on case-based discussions of current diagnosis and management of common pediatric emergencies (co-sponsored by American Academy of Pediatrics)

Lecture series: monthly remote lectures on relevant topics for Bangladeshi physicians provided by pediatric specialists in the U.S.

Rohingya camp medical provider training: hands-on AHA Basic Life Support (BLS) & Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP) for the medical providers in refugee camps in Cox's Bazar near the Myanmar border

Residency application workshops: yearly workshops for international medical graduates and medical students applying for U.S. Residency programs

Free Medical Clinics: PEDSI volunteers conducted free clinics in Capiz and Guimares in Philippines and provided care and medications to large numbers of children from low income and indigenous populations.

Global health electives: providing educational opportunities through global health electives for pediatric residents in U.S.
